MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM Call for Application – Academic Year 2024-2026

Based on the announcement of Hanoi Medical University on postgraduate studies application and examination for the academic year of 2024 – 2026, the School of Preventive Medicine and Public Health (SPMPH) is pleased to invite qualified and interested candidates to apply for a place in the full-time International Master of Public Health program (Cohort 9, 2024 – 2026), commencing around October 2024.

Program Overview

The full-time Master of Public Health International Program at Hanoi Medical University, first established in 2015, is designed to train a new generation of competent public health researchers and practitioners. The program offers two tracks — Master of Science in Public Health and Master of Applied Public Health — with the former emphasizing developing the capacity to carry out public health research while the later developing the capacity to carry out public health interventions.

Training duration: 18 months (Dec 2024 to Jul 2026)

Tuition fee: 5,250 USD (converted to Vietnamese Dong at the time of first payment). A potential number of merit-based scholarships are available for selected students. Students are also supported to apply for scholarships from other sources.

Eligibility and Admission Criteria

Applicants from any country are eligible for the program and should read carefully the attached signed Annoucement dated 28 April 2024 which had detailed guidelines for submission documents.

Scholarships: It is anticipated that about 20 prospective students will be admitted for this 2024 - 2026 intake (10 for Master of Science in Public Health Track, and 15 for Master of Applied Public Health). Scholarships (up to 50% of tuition fees) will be awarded based on the academic merits and competencies of candidates.

Application fee: 20 USD (Applicants may pay cash or make a wire transfer at the time of submitting their application. International applicants will be given details for transfer after submitting the applications). This fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee admission.

Time for online register: from 8:00am on Oct 1, 2024 to 4:30pm on Oct 15, 2024 (detailed instructions are available at the application portal website http://tuyensinh.hmu.edu.vn and our postgraduate website here). After successfully registering online, candidates will be provided with 01 profile code (also the candidate code, exam registration number, student code after matriculation) in the confirmation email of online registration.
